



## **2019 RULES for SPECIFIC BRONCOS SPONSORED COMPETITIONS**

**All Referee and Sports Medicine Costs are covered by Broncos Development (see contact at end of these rules)**

### **RENOUF SHIELD (Yr 8), HANCOCK CUP (Yr 9)**

- ❖ REFER TO BRONCOS COMPETITIONS AGE LIMITS
- ❖ ALL GAMES ARE PLAYED UNDER THE NATIONAL SAFEPLAY CODE ([www.qrl.com.au](http://www.qrl.com.au))
- ❖ **A SQUAD OF SEVENTEEN (17) PLAYERS MAY BE USED**
- ❖ **EIGHT (8) INTERCHANGES ARE ALLOWED**
- ❖ GAMES SHALL BE OF 2 X 25 MINUTE HALVES, with a FIVE (5) MINUTE HALFTIME
- ❖ NO TIME OFF FOR INJURIES
- ❖ SIN BIN TIME SHALL BE 5 MINUTES
- ❖ FOLLOWING THE ROUNDS, TEAMS WILL BE RANKED 1 – 8, AND PROCEED TO THE KNOCKOUT “ROUND OF 16” IN TERM 3
- ❖ REIMBURSEMENT OF 50% OF TRAVEL COSTS FROM ROUND OF 16 TO FINALS

### **DE VERE CUP (Year 10)**

- ❖ A LEVEL 2, YEAR 10 COMPETITION (REFER TO AGE LIMITS)
- ❖ AT THE COMPLETION OF THE ROUNDS, THE TOP 2 TEAMS FROM EACH POOL WILL PLAY CROSS POOLS (1A v 2B, 1B v 2A), WITH THE WINNERS TO ASSUME POSITIONS 7 and 8 IN THE QUARTER FINALS OF THE WALTERS CUP,
- ❖ ALL GAMES ARE PLAYED UNDER THE NATIONAL SAFEPLAY CODE
- ❖ A SQUAD OF NINETEEN (19) PLAYERS MAY BE USED.
- ❖ UNLIMITED INTERCHANGES ARE ALLOWED
- ❖ GAMES SHALL BE OF 2 X 25 MINUTE HALVES, with a FIVE (5) MINUTE HALF TIME.
- ❖ NO TIME OFF FOR INJURIES
- ❖ SIN BIN TIME SHALL BE 5 MINUTES
- ❖ REIMBURSEMENT OF 50% TRAVEL COSTS FOR WALTERS CUP FINAL SERIES

### **GEE SHIELD (Open B)**

- ❖ A LEVEL 2 OPEN GRADE COMPETITION.
- ❖ ALL PLAYERS MUST BE OF A MINIMUM AGE OF SIXTEEN (16) YEARS, AND A MAXIMUM AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS DURING THE YEAR OF COMPETITION.
- ❖ A SQUAD OF NINETEEN (19) PLAYERS MAY BE USED.
- ❖ UNLIMITED INTERCHANGES ARE ALLOWED
- ❖ GAMES SHALL BE OF 2 X 25 MINUTE HALVES, with a FIVE (5) MINUTE HALF TIME
- ❖ NO TIME OFF FOR INJURIES
- ❖ SIN BIN TIME SHALL BE 5 MINUTES
- ❖ AT THE COMPLETION OF THE ROUNDS, THE “TOP 2” TEAMS FROM EACH POOL WILL PLAY CROSS POOLS (1A v 2B, 1B v 2A), WITH THE WINNERS TO QUALIFY FOR THE PLAYOFFS FOR TEAMS 7 & 8 IN THE STH QLD QUARTER FINALS OF THE NATIONAL SCHOOLBOY CUP.
- ❖ REIMBURSEMENT OF 50% OF TRAVEL COSTS (ONCE QUALIFIED FOR GIO CUP QUARTER FINAL’S). TRAVEL IS AS PER NATIONAL SCHOOLBOY CUP RULES.



### **LANGER RESERVE GRADE**

- A LEVEL 2 OPEN COMPETITION FOR THE SECOND TEAMS OF LANGER SCHOOLS
- THE TOP 4 TEAMS, AT THE END OF THE COMPLETED ROUNDS, WILL PLAY SEMIFINALS (1 v 4, 2v 3), WITH THE WINNERS TO PLAY A TROPHY FINAL.
- ALL PLAYING RULES AS PER GEE SHIELD
- TRAVEL IS WITH LANGER AND WALTERS

### **WALTERS CUP (Yr 10)**

- ❖ A LEVEL 3, YEAR 10 COMPETITION (REFER TO “AGE LIMITS”) FOR UP TO SIX (6) SCHOOLS
- ❖ SCHOOLS MUST HAVE A TEAM IN THE ” LANGER TROPHY” TO QUALIFY.
- ❖ **A SQUAD OF SEVENTEEN (17) PLAYERS MAY BE USED**
- ❖ **EIGHT (8) INTERCHANGES MAY BE USED**
- ❖ GAMES SHALL BE OF 2 X 25 MINUTE HALVES, with a FIVE (5) MINUTE HALF TIME
- ❖ NO TIME OFF FOR INJURIES
- ❖ SIN BIN TIME SHALL BE 5 MINUTES
- ❖ FOLLOWING THE ROUNDS, TEAMS WILL BE RANKED 1 – 6, AND JOINED BY THE TOP 2 TEAMS FROM THE DE VERE CUP TO PROCEED TO THE QUARTER FINALS IN TERM 3
- ❖ REIMBURSEMENT OF 50% OF TRAVEL COSTS FOR ALL ROUNDS

### **LANGER TROPHY (Open A)**

- ❖ A LEVEL 3 OPEN GRADE COMPETITION FOR UP TO SIX (6) SCHOOLS
- ❖ THESE SCHOOLS ARE GUARANTEED ENTRY INTO THE SOUTH QUEENSLAND QUARTER FINALS OF THE NATIONAL SCHOOLBOY CUP
- ❖ ALL PLAYERS MUST BE OF A MINIMUM AGE OF SIXTEEN (16) YEARS AND A MAXIMUM AGE OF EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS DURING THE YEAR OF COMPETITION
- ❖ **A SQUAD OF SEVENTEEN (17) PLAYERS MAY BE USED**
- ❖ **TEN (10) INTERCHANGES MAY BE USED**
- ❖ **GAMES SHALL BE OF 2 X 30 MINUTE HALVES, WITH A 5 MINUTE HALF TIME**
- ❖ NO TIME OFF FOR INJURIES
- ❖ SIN BIN TIME SHALL BE 10 MINUTES
- ❖ REIMBURSEMENT OF 50% OF TRAVEL COSTS FOR ALL ROUNDS.

### **BRONCOS OLD BOYS TROPHY (Year 7) – See Age Limits. (Played under International Rules)**

No round robin competition will be organized by the Broncos. Four Gala Days will be played during 2019. Schools need to nominate for these days.

The Final Gala Day on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> August will determine the two schools to play for the Broncos Old Boys Trophy.
